Welcome to the 2020-2021 Skating Season! Although this year may look different, we are happy to be back at the rink and confident that our skaters will enjoy their time on the ice!

We would like to inform you of the new rules and regulations as set in place by the City of Warman for this facility, as dictated by the Government of Saskatchewan's Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan.

We ask that parents fully read and understand the rules set in place and take note that **EVERYONE MUST FOLLOW THE RULES** in order to keep the children, parents, and staff at the facility safe during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Maximum capacity at the Diamond Arena is 91 people.

Failure to follow these rules will result in the spectator seating being closed.

WOSC also reminds the club members that we are volunteers, and that verbal abuse or harassment will not be tolerated in any manner.

DIAMOND RODEO ARENA

This document is outlining how the Diamond Rodeo Arena is implementing measures to prevent the transmission of COVID-19. The health and safety of guests and staff at the Diamond Rodeo Arena remains our top priority. The Diamond Rodeo Arena is aligning with provincial guidelines as well as national sporting body protocols for facility operations. All user groups operating in the Diamond Rodeo Arena must comply with the following protocol. Groups and participants found not following these protocols may be asked to leave.

COVID-19 droplet transmission is much more likely when individuals are in close contact. The likelihood of transmission between individuals participating in sport, physical activity and recreation in an indoor setting is significantly higher.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Stay home if you are sick. Those showing symptoms of COVID-19 are advised to contact the Saskatchewan Healthline at 811 for further guidance. **Masks are mandatory** for everyone, except when participating in the activity.

PROCEDURE FOR ENTERING THE BUILDING

- The **entrance doors** to the Diamond Rodeo Arena will be the **2 south main doors** and the **exit doors** will be the **2 west doors located by the referee room** or the **east door located past the concession**.
- Use the hand sanitizer at the front entrance prior to continuing into the building. **Sign in at the front entrance table for contact tracing using the QR code.**
- Patrons of the facility must follow the displayed signage to ensure minimal contact and safe procedures.
- Patrons are to limit their time spent in the facility, as well as maintain physical distancing when returning to their vehicles or homes.

DESIGNATED WEST AND EAST AREAS

- The arena ice surface and lobby will be divided into 2 halves, **EAST** and **WEST**.
- **PreCanSkate** is on the **WEST** side, therefore those skaters and spectators will:
 - **Finish getting ready by utilizing the area identified as WEST in the lobby or dressing room #5.**
 - **Access the ice surface from the WEST gate and leave the ice surface from the WEST gate.**
 - **Utilize the ice surface spectator seating identified as WEST (player bench side).**
 - **Utilize the area identified as WEST in the lobby or dressing room #5 to prepare to leave the facility.**
 - **Exit the arena by using the door on the WEST side of the arena located by the referee room.**
 - **The parent on the ice MUST wear a CSA approved hockey helmet and skates.**
- **CANSKATE, all STAR groups, and Coaches** are on the **EAST** side, therefore those skaters and spectators will:
 - **Finish getting ready by utilizing the area identified as EAST in the lobby or dressing room #6.**
 - **Access the ice surface from the EAST gate and leave the ice surface from the EAST gate.**
 - **Utilize the ice surface spectator seating identified as EAST.**
 - **Utilize the area identified as EAST in the lobby or dressing room #6 to prepare to leave the facility.**
 - **Exit the arena by using the door on the EAST side of the arena located by the concession.**

- Warman Osler Skating Club requires all patrons entering the facility to sign in by the hand sanitizer to allow WOSC proper contract tracing, monitoring, and screening of all patrons upon arrival at the facility.
- All participants are expected to come dressed.
- Showers will NOT be available.
- Groups are NOT to line up at the gates awaiting their ice time.
- Arrive at the facility no more than 30 minutes before your scheduled time. Those arriving earlier will be asked to wait outside until 30 minutes before the scheduled start time.
- Attendees must vacate the facility with 15 minutes after their assigned ice time to allow staff time to disinfect the space prior to the next group.
- Drinking Fountains are NOT available.
- Coaches and PA's working the score clock and sound booth will be required to sanitize their hands before and after use. The sound booth will be available by pre-request ONLY.

SPECTATORS

- Ice surface spectator seating will be permitted, and spectators must not total more than the maximum gathering limits per the public health order per team at each game/activity and must ensure physical distancing between non-household members. **Maximum capacity is 91 people** (66 seated outside, 10 standing outside, 15 seated inside), while still maintaining 6 feet of social distancing.
- WOSC still requests minimal spectators attend events and remind parents and caregivers that children must be with them at all times. **Children are not allowed to run around.**
- Spectators must maintain distancing of at least two meters from other members of the public.
- Spitting (includes seeds, tobacco, and fluids) and other similar activities increase the risk of transmission of COVID-19 and are not permitted.
- Individuals must not share personal items (i.e. equipment or beverage containers).
- Congratulatory gestures such as high fives and handshakes are not permitted. Spectators, participants and players, staff, coaches, and volunteers should try to minimize cheering and whistling as much as possible to control the spread of COVID-19.
