

## Warman Osler Skating Club Fundraising Policy

The Warman Osler Skating Club Board of Directors (Executive) will develop an annual fundraising plan each season. The planned policy will be discussed and approved before the skating season begins in October.

## Warman Osler Skating Club Fundraising Policy for 2023-2024:

\*Note – if you have credits from the 2022-2023 skating season, you MUST use them for the 2023-2024 season. If your credits are not used, they are resigned to the Warman Osler Skating Club. Credits will not be applied to any fundraising endeavors moving forward (unless otherwise noted).

- **1.** There is a mandatory \$200.00 fundraising fee (per family) for the 2023-2024 skating season. This fee is due with registration fees on September 1, 2023.
- **2.** Families will have a chance to recoup their fundraising fee by selling product from the fundraising options available with our Club. Options will be available in October once the skating season starts.
- **3.** Fundraising is a huge part of the success of our club! You will be entered to win a \$50.00 gift card at Hector's Grub Hub if you participate in the following extra fundraising endeavours:
  - a. Sell an online lotto book (details will be provided in October)
  - b. Email us a picture of your Sarcan Drop & Go tag
- \*Draw will be made in January 2024
- **4.** Credits <u>will be given</u> for Public Skate Marshalling. **Two people** must work 1 shift which earns \$50.00. Credits must be used the following season, or they are resigned to the Warman Osler Skating Club.
- **5.** Credits <u>will be given</u> for Program Assisting 1 shift earns \$5.00 credit to skater's family to use towards next season fees or to pay for Skate Canada tests (must be STAR 1-2 to program assist). All credits earned via Program Assisting must be used the following season, or they are resigned to the Warman Osler Skating Club.
